GUIDE TO FACE-TO-FACE LEARNING



Classes will look differently at WHSC as we continue to manage the ongoing restrictions caused by COVID-19. Please refer to this Guide regularly.

What will my school day look like?

- You will follow your Compass timetable.
- **Entrances and exits for common areas will be clearly marked.** Be mindful of these and be sure to follow them.
- **Mobile phones are not allowed.** They must remain turned off and in your locker at all times.
- **Classrooms will be set up to enable social distancing during classes.** Students must ensure to maintain 1.5 meters social distancing where possible and abide by their teacher's instructions.
- **The Canteen will be open.** All students must follow the social distancing marks on the floor when lining up to avoid crowding. Please pay by EFTPOS where possible.
- **Students must not come to the Staff Room.** If you have a question or a query for your teacher, contact them via Teams.

What will my learning look like?

- You will continue to use Teams and online learning tools in the classroom for all classes.
- Information and work sheets will be digital. Paper hand-outs will be avoided.
- Teachers will be mindful when sharing essential class materials. Steps will be taken to clean any shared materials or equipment between students.

What do I need to bring to class?

- Your own drink bottle, pens, books and laptop (fully charged) appropriate for each class.
- Teachers will not be loaning pens or classroom items to students.
- You may wear gloves to class if you wish.

How do I contact my teacher?

- As with Interactive Lessons during Remote Learning, Teams will be the main source of communication with teaching staff.
- In **Class Teams**, your teachers will provide you with classwork, assignments, collaborative tasks, and other important class information.
- In **Year Level Teams**, your Year Level Coordinator will provide you with Year level notices, competitions, activities, and assemblies.

What if I feel sick?

- If you wake up and feel unwell, **do not come to school.** You must seek medical advice.
- If you feel unwell during the day, you **must tell your teacher** immediately. You will be sent to the sickbay and your parents may be called.
