### PHYSICAL EDUCATION & INTER-SCHOOL SPORT (YEARS 7 TO 12)

Top	WHSC Polo shirt with logo, WHSC Rugby top with logo, WHSC Navy blue jacket with logo
Shorts	Navy blue only (logo preferred)
Pants	Navy blue track pants
Socks	White sports socks or navy blue football socks.
Shoes	Sport shoes with non-marking soles

***Interschool sport students must wear full physical education uniform to and from College.  
Students who have a scheduled Physical Education class in Period 1 may come to school in full sport uniform. Students who have a scheduled Physical Education class in Period 4 may leave school in full sport uniform. For all other periods, students must change at school.***

#### PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Full school uniform should be worn neatly to and from school.
- White t-shirts may be worn under shirt but MUST NOT be visible.
- Make-up and jewellery other than a wrist watch, ear stud and/or sleeper in each ear is not part of the College Dress Code.
- No boots or sneakers are to be worn to school (unless free dress day).

## UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS - SHOES

### **T BAR SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED**

Parents purchasing uniforms are reminded that it is our shared expectation that students will wear *full* school uniform at *all* times. If on rare occasions a student is obliged to be out of uniform, a written note must be provided to the Year Level Coordinator and a uniform pass will be issued.

In particular, shoes must be **black leather and cover the foot**. **Slip-on canvas shoes, t-bars and sneakers are not permitted**. OHS legislation demands that footwear be safe for the activities undertaken. At school this includes Science experiments with chemicals, Materials Technology with machinery and tools, Food Technology with boiling water and other subjects with a range of physical activities.



## OTHER UNIFORM REMINDERS

- *Shoes must be laced at all times*
- **T Bar shoes are not OHS compliant and cannot be worn under any circumstances.**
- *Shirts must be buttoned appropriately (students missing buttons may be required to sew more on!)*
- *T-shirts worn under school shirts must be plain white and not extend beyond the school shirt at the sleeve or waist.*
- *Uniform – Socks may not be worn with tights. White socks must be worn with shorts or dress.*
- *Uniform – Navy tights are winter uniform only.*
- *Make-up and jewellery other than a wrist watch, ear stud and/or sleeper in each ear is not part of the College Dress Code.*
- *Interschool sport students must wear full Physical Education uniform to and from school.*
- *Students who have a scheduled Physical Education class in Period 1 may come to school in full sport uniform.*
- *Students who have a scheduled Physical Education class in Period 4 may leave school in full sport uniform.*

Students who are **not** in correct uniform will be asked (and assisted where possible) to comply. If they do not, a range of whole school consequences apply, including detention. Students who are not properly attired for activities may be excluded for OHS reasons.

It is our also our expectation (and that of our local community) that students wear correct uniform whilst travelling to and from school.

We seek your support in ensuring students are attired consistent with the College Dress Code.
